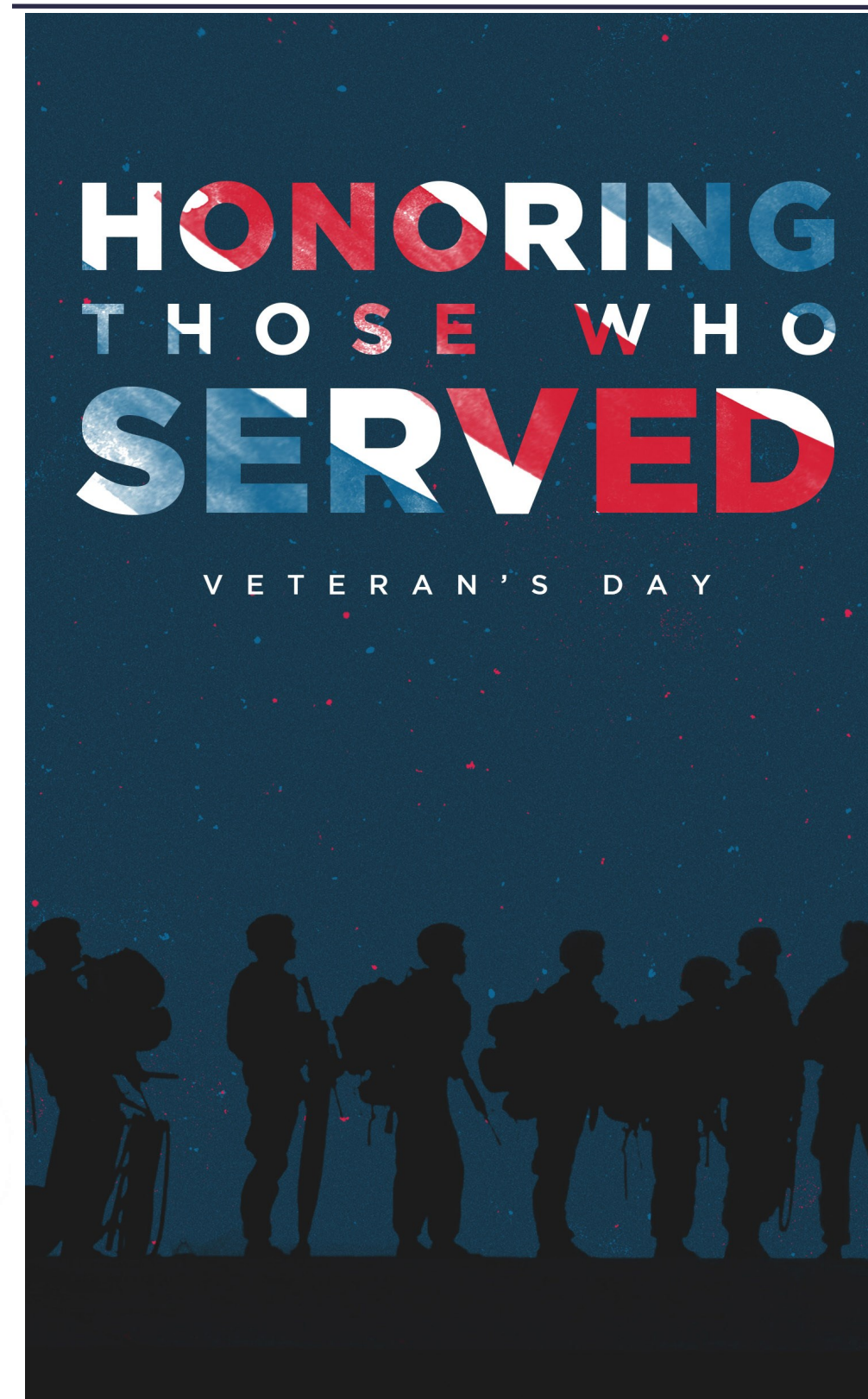
Christmas in the Country
